Passport Scholarship:

Many individuals have donated to support passport scholarships for CSU students. We are looking for students who are first-time adult applicants with financial need. We hope to break down barriers to international experiences for students. Students do not have to study abroad to be eligible. Passports are valid for 10 years – please encourage even those students who do not have international travel plans to apply.

During the Spring 2022 semester, selected students will be awarded \$2,000 each and have the opportunity to learn a range of technical and artistic skills related to filmmaking and visual storytelling. Students will learn to work as a film crew with professional filmmakers and cinema equipment to produce, shoot, and edit a short documentary film.

Students will also meet and connect with members of [Next 100 Colorado](#)—a BIPOC coalition for and by the next generation of environmental leaders, working to build a more inclusive, equal, and just future. The theme of the film will be crafted collaboratively by the group and should, in some way, highlight BIPOC experiences related to conservation, environmental, and public lands issues.

Applications will be accepted until December 12, 2021, and five students will be awarded the scholarship for the spring semester. Undergraduate and graduate students in any field of study are eligible, and students interested in conservation and natural resources; public lands and recreation; environmental justice; storytelling; filmmaking; and diversity, equity, equity are encouraged to apply.

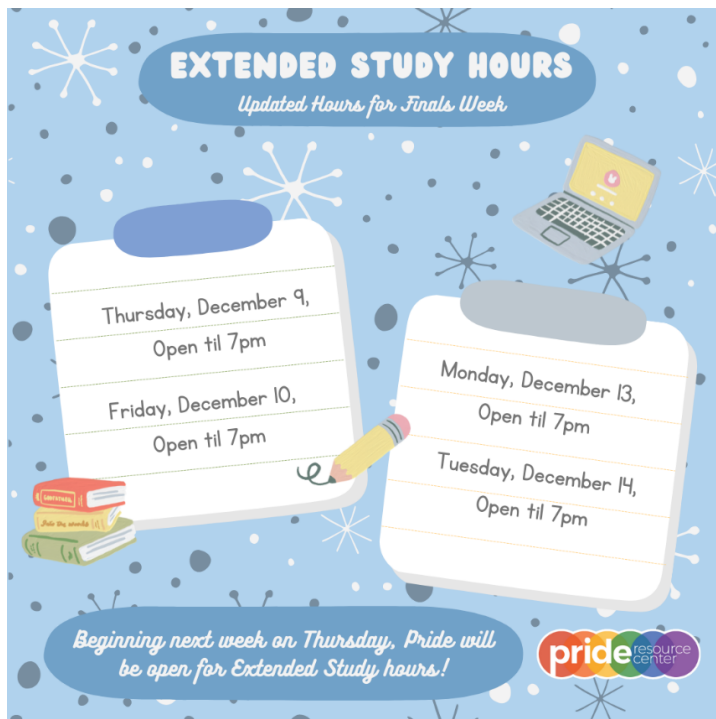

The Summer Research Training Programs (SRTP) are paid, 8-week research internships on the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus, with each track focusing on a different aspect of science. **These programs are aimed at creating opportunities for undergraduate students who have been historically underrepresented in science.** The 8-week internship will culminate in both oral and poster presentations as part of a campus-wide summer research symposium. Participation in the program provides students with hands-on experience in a laboratory environment, training to succeed in scientific careers, and a network of faculty and graduate students to provide longitudinal mentorship.
