### **Passport Scholarship:**

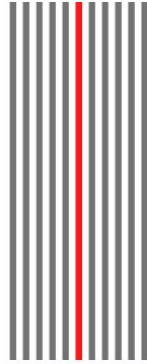

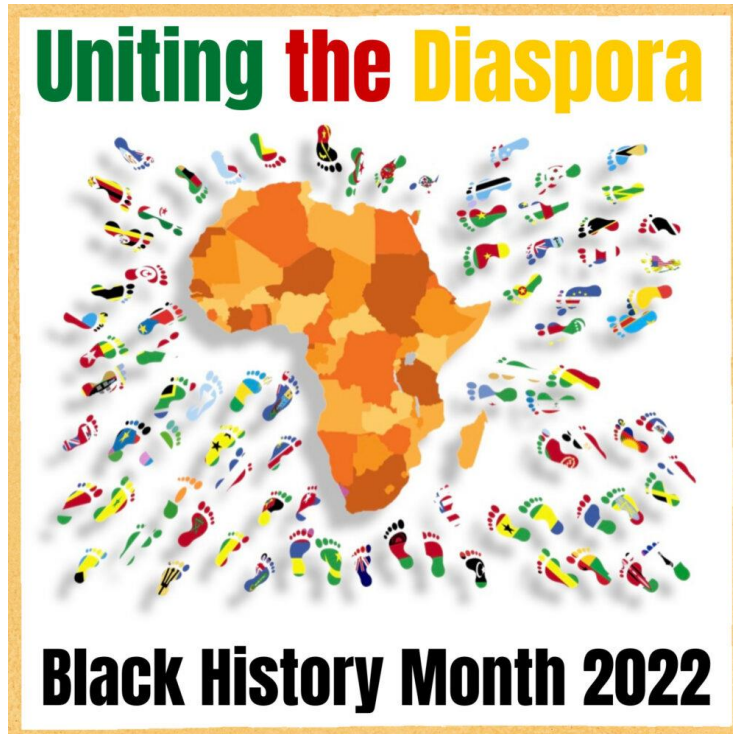
