Passport Scholarship:

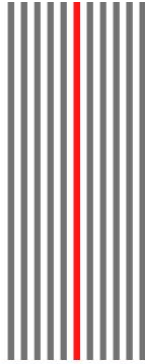

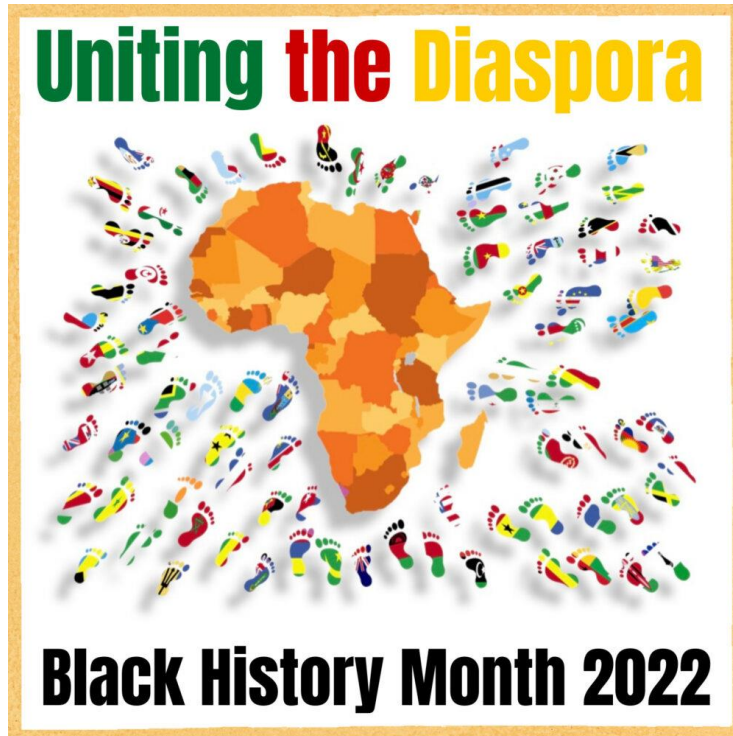
